Dear Parent/Guardian,

Cordial Greetings to you!

As the academic session comes to an end, I thank God and you dear collaborators for your kind and enthusiastic cooperation that has allowed us to offer the best towards the growth and development of your children. This year is very special to us as we have the first batch of Higher Secondary for the Board examinations. I offer my best wishes to the girls of classes X & XII as they appear in the Board Examinations.

Carmel Convent School is known for its quality education and for the effort it takes to offer varied educational and co-curricular exposures to its students. We were all encouraged by the recognition and accolades we received from various agencies for our efforts. As we conclude this year, we would like to carry with us all the new learnings and look towards the new session with hope and renewed vigour. Thus, I have some important communications for your kind consideration and affirmative action.

Change of Board: We have been receiving numerous requests for change of Board (affiliation) from parents as well as students. Having been in the sector for 24 years, we have also come to realize that it is time we heeded to the requests. Accordingly, the school Management placed the proposal for change of Board to CBSE or ICSE at the joint meeting of the Managing Committee and PTA Executive that was held on 21st January. The members of the Committee were unanimous in their resolution that the School must move from JKBOSE to CBSE based on the majority opinion of all the stakeholders. We have already started working on the proposal by approaching the government for No-Objection Certificate. While that application is under process, it is important for us to know your choice and willingness to switch board of education. Thus, through the medium of this circular, I am inviting all our worthy parents to give their choices by signing and returning the pull-out given at the end of this circular. We are asking you to give your choice between JKBOSE or CBSE. Your responses are crucial for our final decision making. We are hopeful that the government will grant us the necessary permission at the earliest. Kindly return the signed consent by or before the 10th March.

School Fees: At the joint meeting of the Managing Committee and PTA Executive that was held on 21st January it was unanimously resolved to increase the school fees by 10.00%. However, the actual increase has been tied to 6% overall. I am certain that all the patrons of Carmel agree that the school offers total value for money since the Management takes care to provide the best of avenues for our girls to excel in their studies besides sharpening their skills in co-curricular activities.
