

UNIFORM POLICY

The students are required to wear during school hours. School uniform should be worn with pride as it reflects the distinct nature of our school. They should come in neat and clean uniforms with their school ID Cards.

If the child is not in proper school uniform, a notification from the school is sent to the parents, which must be signed and returned to school. If the child exhibits same behavior parents receive a notice to meet with the Principal or discipline in-charge teacher.

JEWELLERY: School Uniform forbids the use of jewellery, only the following jewellery is allowed during school time. (Gold or silver stud earrings). Girls are not allowed to wear fancy bangles and finger rings. No jewellery should be worn when involved in Interschool Sports or Competitive Sports Events. No chains or necklaces are allowed.

HAIR: All students with long hair must have their hair tied back off their face. Long hair must be plaited neatly and tied with a black ribbon of reasonable length. In the case of short hair, black hair bands, ribbons or hair ties must be black. No colouring streaking of child's hair unless permission is sought and granted by the school. No puffs and not more than four hairpins are allowed.

NAIL POLISH: Growing of nails and the use of Nail polish, Henna Mehandi tattoos etc. not permitted during school time.

Footwear: School Shoes should be worn during school hours.(Slippers are allowed in case of injury with a prior permission of the class teacher).
