### How to Help Your Children With Their Homework?



#### Create a homework-friendly zone

Make sure your children have a well-lit area in which to do their homework. Maintain easy access to supplies such as paper, pencils, glue, and scissors

#### Establish a regular study time

### Literary Non-Fiction

A genre of writing that uses literary styles and techniques to create factually accurate stories e.g. biography, autobiography, memoirs, personal essay, narrative journalism and narrative history.





### Expository writing

Types of texts that exist to provide facts in a way that is educational and informative. They usually aim to have a more neutral and unbiased tone e.g. text books, newspaper or magazine articles, selfhelp books, history books, encyclopaedias etc.

#### Persuasive Texts

Texts whereby the author takes an argumentative position and tries to persuade the reader through evidence e.g. opinion pieces, editorials, open letters, advertisements and political speeches.





#### Technical Writing

This category includes academic, technical or procedural writing whereby a professional or expert conveys information about specialized topics or provides instructions to explain technical concepts e.g. scientific texts, scholarly articles, instruction manuals etc.

### Purpose



We can discuss the purpose of information texts in a general sense by using words such as to inform, persuade, critique, argue, comment on, entertain, advise, satirise, protest, reflect and so on. Sometimes you'll be asked to information dentify the author's point of view. This means you'll be looking for their particular position, stance or attitude towards a topic. If this is presented in a strong and assertive way, we might refer to it as the author's argument. That is, when they give a reason or set of reasons with the aim of persuading the audience to agree with their viewpoint.

Plants can live in jungles, deserts, and almost everywhere else you can think of. Let's explore some examples of plants, their habitats, and how they survive.

### **Aloe Plants**



- They grow well in dry, arid places.
- Their fleshy stems, leaves, and roots allow them to store much water.
- The thick waxy coating on their leaves helps prevent excessive moisture loss.



### **Baobab Trees**

- They survive in low-lying, arid regions.
- Their spongy trunk allows them to store up to 100,000 liters of water.
- Some varieties have slick and shiny bark that reflects light and keep them cool.

### **Conifer Trees**

- They can survive the harsh and freezing winters.
- Their long, needle-like leaves have waxy coatings that reduce moisture loss.
- They also produce cones instead of flowers.





### Mangroves

- Mangrove trees sit in swampy, salty, and oxygenpoor environments all year.
- To ensure they get enough oxygen, they grow roots upward out of the soil.
